Patricia Lee McMullen-Mikles (1951-2015), an American Artist, was born in Greensburg, Kansas on October 18, 1951, and passed away on November 2nd, 2015 in Cottonwood, Arizona. She attained a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree (1973) and a Master of Education degree (1976) from the University of Northern Colorado in Greeley.

Patricia began her 42-year teaching career in 1973, culminating in a 20-year tenure at Yavapai College. Her curriculum vitae included: Drawing, Watercolor, Oil and Acrylic Painting, Photography, Batik, Design, Color Theory, and Portfolio Development.

She was a juried member of the Northern Arizona Watercolor Society, served many years in the American Association of Women in Community Colleges, and held memberships in the Sedona Art Center, and the Scottsdale Artists School. She was a favorite in the arts community for teaching workshops and doing demonstrations.

She was a long-time participant in the Made in Clarkdale Artists and their exhibitions. Patricia created the Verde Gallery at Yavapai College and served as its director from (2003-2006).
