Guillaume Azoulay is a self-taught artist, born in Casablanca, Morocco in 1949. His parents moved the family to Paris in 1959. He began selling his drawings on the streets and left home at age 14, hitchhiking across Europe and the Middle East.

Azoulay is internationally appreciated and collected. He is the youngest artist to be accepted into the permanent archives of the *Musee du Louvre* in Paris.
